**ENDORING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2011
UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Baltimore region, and includes official representatives of the cities of Annapolis and Baltimore, the counties of Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford, and Howard, and the Maryland Departments of Transportation, the Environment, and Planning; and

WHEREAS, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board manages and provides direction to the work tasks necessary for the completion of the Unified Planning Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board approved the Fiscal Year 2011 Unified Planning Work Program and Budget at its meeting on April 27, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Howard County requests that the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board reduce the approved \$755,440 Fiscal Year 2011 Unified Work Program Budget for Howard County by \$1,292 (Attachment A); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board approves the amendment reducing the overall Fiscal Year 2011 Unified Planning Work Program to \$7,874,298.
