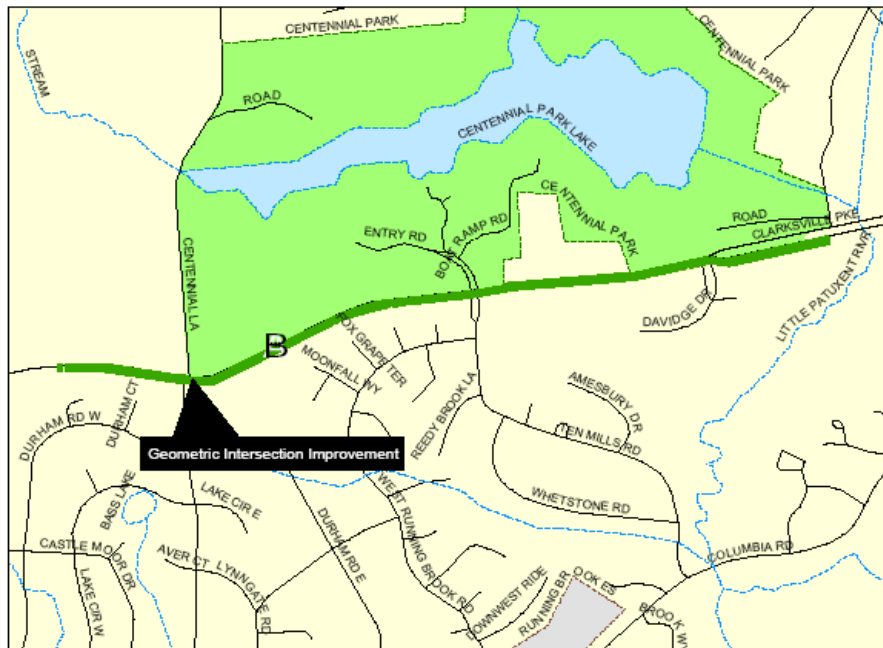


Proposed Plan Amendment
April 2005

Amendment	MD 108 widening
Proposed Action	Amend the 2004 Baltimore Regional Transportation Plan (2004 B RTP) to add a project for construction of two additional lanes (2 to 4) on MD 108 between Woodland Road to 1200 feet west of Centennial Lane crossing (1.4 miles). This project will also include improved signalization at MD 108 and Centennial Lane.
Justification	This project will mitigate severe congestion and delays
Proposer	Howard County with the State Highway Administration
Total Cost	\$6,000,000 funded with Howard County excise tax backed bonds
Year of Operation	2009
Air Quality	This project will be included in an air quality conformity determination (available June 1) if no adverse/substantive comments are received during the initial comment period.
