BID NO. 10-191 BULK CHEMICALS FOR WATER & WASTEWATER TREATMENT

CONTRACT ADDENDUM NO. 1

THIS ADDENDUM entered into this 2nd day of May, 2011, by and between HARFORD COUNTY, MARYLAND, a body corporate and politic of the State of Maryland, hereinafter called the "County", and **POLYDYNE INC., One Chemical Plant Road, Riceboro, Georgia 31323**, hereinafter called the "Contractor" is made to this agreement between the same parties dated June 10, 2010.

WHEREAS, the Contractor agreed to provide specific bulk chemicals to Harford County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, per Section VII of the Agreement, the County has the exclusive option of extending the Agreement for three (3) additional one (1) year periods and the Contractor may submit a request for a price increase per contract year ; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to extend the Agreement for an additional one year period and the Contractor has submitted a request dated April 26, 2011 for a price increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the representations, covenants and promises and the recitals which are incorporated herein, the parties, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

The term of this Agreement will continue en force for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.


The request for a 5% increase in prices has been granted and will become effective June 10, 2011 as follows:


