#### CONTRACT ADDENDUM NO. 1

**THIS ADDENDUM** entered into this 16nd day of May, 2011, by and between HARFORD COUNTY, MARYLAND, a body corporate and politic of the State of Maryland, hereinafter called the "County", and **UNIVAR USA INC., 532 E. Emaus Street, Middletown, Pennsylvania 17057**, hereinafter called the "Contractor" is made to this agreement between the same parties dated June 10, 2010.




