Population and Household Changes between Round 7-B and Round 7-A

Anne Arundel County submitted modest adjustments to population and households

Baltimore City revised its population and households upward by 1%

Baltimore County increased its population estimates by nearly 2% and households by 2%

Carroll County continued to reduce their population and household estimates as they did in Round 7-A

Harford County reductions appear to reflect impacts of current economic conditions and they tend to dissipate after 2015

Howard County submitted modest adjustments to population and households

Employment Changes between Round 7-B and Round 7-A

Anne Arundel County submitted major employment reductions in estimates for the Fort Meade area

Baltimore City submitted modest changes to employment estimates in the out years

Baltimore County's revisions represent a 7.1% increase over Round 7-A employment totals by 2035

Carroll County made no employment changes between the two forecasts

Harford County made modest adjustments to employment between the two forecasts

Howard County made no employment changes between the two forecasts
