

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program



On behalf of the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB), the Baltimore Metropolitan Council (BMC) has developed a policy for a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program that complies with U.S. DOT regulations for federal financial assistance. This policy will guide the BMC approach to contracts and subcontracts.

The DBE Program:

- Establishes a DBE Program Liaison Officer
- Sets an overall annual goal for DBE participation
- Identifies the Maryland Department of Transportation as the organization that maintains a directory for DBE certification
- Outlines an approach to program monitoring
