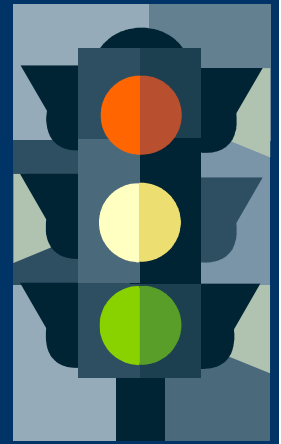


Baltimore – Washington Regional Traffic Signal Forum
