Walk Smart

- Look left-right-left, and if it's clear, begin crossing, looking over your shoulders for turning vehicles.
- Cross the street between cross walk markings.
- Always obey traffic signs, signals and markings.
- Watch for cars.
- Make eye contact with drivers to ensure they see you.
- Wear light colored or reflective clothing to be more visible at night.
- Cross safely. Don't be dead right!

Stay alert. Slow down. Share the road with bicyclists and pedestrians.
