

# Open For Public Review

## Final Draft 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program and Draft Air Quality Conformity Determination

The Baltimore Regional Transportation Board has released the Final Draft FY 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program for public review. The TIP is a list of transportation priorities and projects that are requesting federal funding over the next 5 years.

Also released for public review is the Draft Air Quality Conformity Determination of the Draft Plan for Transportation Outlook 2035 and the Final Draft FY 2008-2012 TIP. This report concludes that implementation of the projects in these two draft plans does not worsen the region's air quality or delay the timely attainment of national ambient air quality standards.
