



Improving Safety On MD 32

Wellworth Way Access Management Improvements

The MD State Highway Administration is requesting an amendment to the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program to add funding to the *MD 32 - Wellworth Way Access Management Improvements project*.

Funds, in the amount of \$886,000, will be used to purchase right-of-way (ROW) to provide access for homes as a result of removing private driveways currently on MD 32. New access will be from Rosemary Lane and Wellworth Way.

The overall purpose of this project, which has completed the planning phase, is to address safety concerns by exploring options to upgrade MD 32 (MD 108 to I-70) in Howard County.

The Selected Alternative, which is the result of a multi-year planning study, would provide a 4-lane, access controlled, divided highway with a 34-foot median. Shoulders will accommodate bicycles. Intersections will be replaced with interchanges at Linden Church Rd (Option 2), Dayton Shop, Burntwoods Rd (Option 3A), Rosemary Ln (Option 2A), and I-70 (Option 2). Access to Nixon's Farm Ln and the adjacent residential properties would be provided via the MD 144 Interchange (Option 12M) and access roads. This amendment is a breakout project.

A public review will be held from **Thursday, June 2 through Friday, July 1, 2011**. All mailed comments must be received no later than 3 days after the close of the comment period.
