# 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

---

Baltimore City and the State Highway Administration (SHA) are proposing to amend the Fiscal Year 2008-2012 Baltimore Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) by adding funding for the following projects:

- o Five segments of road resurfacing and rehabilitation (Baltimore City)
- o Edmondson Village Street Lighting and Pedestrian Safety Improvements (Baltimore City)
- o Road resurfacing of MD 462 (SHA in Harford County)
- o Bridge Painting (SHA in Anne Arundel County)

The source of funding for all of these proposed projects is the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 funds.
