AMENDMENT

2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

The Maryland Department of Transportation, on behalf of the Maryland Transit Administration, is proposing to amend the 2008-2012 Baltimore Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include funds from the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act in two ways:

Five new projects will be added to the TIP, including: Light Rail Yard Switch Upgrades, Mondawmin Transit Center Bus Loop Repaving, NW Bus Division HVAC Upgrade, West Baltimore MARC Station Parking Improvements, and Light Rail Substation Breaker Replacements.

Three projects already in the TIP are either receiving additional funding beyond that previously identified or moving funds between activities. This includes MARC Aberdeen Station Relocation Study, Annapolis Transit and Harford Transit.
