The MD Transit Administration (MTA) is updating information on six transit projects and Howard County is proposing to change one transit project in the FY 2010-2013 Baltimore Region Transportation Improvement Program.

The projects proposed for this amendment relate to the following: Bus & Rail System Preservation & Improvement; Howard Street Revitalization; Fare Collection Equipment Preservation Fund; Greyhound Station; Metro Halon Fire Suppression Gas Replacement; MARC Edgewood Area Maintenance Facility Design & Engineering Study; Transit Operations & Maintenance Facility.
