# FY 2011 Goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program

The Baltimore Regional Transportation Board is proposing a goal of twenty percent (20%) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation



through a combined methodology described in 40 CFR 26.45 (c)(5-6). Specifically, the BRTB is using the average of the goals of two Maryland recipients of US Department of Transportation funds located in the same or a substantially similar market as the BRTB.

The two recipients the BRTB has chosen to use in calculating its goal are as follows:

- Baltimore County - The largest and most populous jurisdiction on the BRTB, with an overall FY 2010 Minority Business Enterprise/Women's Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) goal of fifteen (15) percent participation
- MD State Highway Administration - SHA has an overall FY 2010 goal of twenty four (24.3) percent.

The average of these two goals is nineteen (19.65%), which the BRTB has rounded to a goal of twenty (20) percent.

## Public Review and Comment

A public review period will be held from Monday, May 17 through Wednesday, June 16, 2010.
