Questions / **Answers**

1. Can you please provide some clarification about the following?

13.1 Bidders shall extend the same prices, terms and conditions to all Volunteer Fire Departments and EMS Companies requiring these commodities and/or services.

Is this limited to above said agencies in a particular state or territory or would this be any nationwide Volunteer Fire Department and EMS Companies?

This is in the bid document to cover the volunteer fire companies in the MAPT region but could be extended to other agencies outside the region under the Rider Clause. We do not foresee this being a national contract at this time.

The primary reason for this section in the bid document is to delineate the billing responsibility as these volunteer agencies have their own financial systems and the corresponding governmental jurisdictions are not responsible for their bills.

2. Based on my understanding of the terms, awards will be made by each individual agency at a line by line bases. Is that based on just the items listed for that agency?

For example, Anne Arundel has a specific list of items however are they able to award us line items that are listed under Howard County? Or is each agency limited their item list?

Each agency will have input on their own line items. One agency will not have input on another agencies Line Items. That was the reason for keeping the Bid Form with the agencies separate.
