



**Position:** Multimodal Planner

**Salary:** This position offers a competitive salary, dependent upon qualifications and experience.

**Description:** The Baltimore Metropolitan Council (BMC) is a private, non-profit planning entity in the Baltimore region. The BMC's primary function is to support the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB), the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) and its regional transportation planning activities. BMC also provides support to member local governments in several other areas, including procurement, affordable housing, workforce development, reservoir protection and water quality.

BMC is seeking a full time mid-level transportation planner or engineer with interests related to planning for multimodal and alternative transportation modes (transit, bicycle/pedestrian and car sharing).

**Summary of Duties:** This position involves efforts to track and evaluate a range of strategies aimed at reducing traffic congestion while improving air quality and mobility in the Baltimore region. The position will involve coordination with a variety of agencies in the region, support for a regional bicycle and pedestrian advisory group, support for the congestion management process, and transit work group.

Typical duties will include:

- Develops and/or coordinates elements of the long-range transportation plan including research and analysis of component areas such as public transportation and non-motorized transportation.
- Handles multimodal transportation issues on a daily basis. Meets with state and local governments concerning pedestrian and bicycle facilities, transit services and plans, reviews grant requests and assists local agencies in leveraging project grant funding.
- Organizes workshops for the purpose of informing local agencies on transportation issues affecting the region.
- Oversees the work of consultants retained to work on transportation projects.
- Performs data and statistical analysis of transit services to assess system performance, ridership trends, and other metrics.

**Knowledge and Skills:**

- Methods, practices, and procedures involved in regional transportation planning

**Ability To:**

- Work independently and diplomatically with minimal supervision
- Communicate and interact positively
- Effectively communicate complex information, both verbally and in writing
- Organize and facilitate effective meetings, prepare and give presentations
- Establish effective working relationships with co-workers, supervisor, and the public
- Prepare clear and concise reports
- Schedule, coordinate, and manage various projects of varying degrees of difficulty, size and complexity

**Minimum Qualifications:** Requires a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in city/regional/transportation planning, engineering or a related curriculum, plus three years of responsible experience. A Master's Degree may be substituted for one year of experience.
