In the **Baltimore region** in 2008, a total of 231 lives were lost and 23,574 people injured in a total of 50,096 crashes.

**Statewide** in 2008, a total of 592 lives were lost and 48,143 persons injured in 539 fatal crashes and 32,769 injury crashes (totaling 33,308 crashes). Another 62,041 crashes were property damage only (PDO) for a total of 95,349 reported crashes with the possibility of even more injuries unknown or unreported.

**Statewide Pedestrians:** 115 lives lost were pedestrians, 2,469 pedestrians were injured, in a total of 2,822 crashes.

**Statewide Bicyclists:** 7 lives lost were bicyclists, another 633 injured in a total of 799 bicyclist involved crashes.
