1. CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION #22-9 (5 Min)

The BRTB will be asked to consider Resolution #22-9 for approval. The resolution approves the request from MDOT SHA and Baltimore City to amend the 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to provide deck replacement on ten bridges at the I-95/I-695 Interchange and to provide protected bicycle facilities along Central Avenue.

2. CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION #22-10 (5 Min)

The BRTB will be asked to consider Resolution #22-10 for approval. The resolution updates five performance measures to carry out the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), including: 1) the number of motor vehicle crash-related fatalities, 2) the number of motor vehicle crash-related serious injuries, 3) the fatality rate per 100 million vehicle miles of travel, 4) the serious injury rate per 100 million vehicle miles of travel, and 5) the number of non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries.
