### 2. POPULATION ESTIMATES AND COMPONENTS OF CHANGE DASHBOARDS

Mr. Matt Hancock will provide a demonstration of a newly updated Tableau dashboards containing the most recent round of population estimates and components of change for BMC jurisdictions.
