Quick-build projects and programs including converting to more permanent infrastructure	83%
Updates on state initiatives such as the 2050 Maryland Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan 2024 Update	83%
Updates on UPWP projects	83%
Reconnecting Communities Program including outside speakers	67%
RAISE program including outside speakers	67%
