# TLC Program Overview

## Mission

The TLC program will support local governments in their planning and preliminary design efforts to improve quality of life for residents in the region through enhanced transportation access and mobility, better air quality, and improved economic opportunities.

## Goals

- Support the revitalization of existing communities and development of activity centers or ease the movement of goods and services.
- Improve access to opportunities for people of all ages and abilities.
- Provide more travel choices to optimize mobility.
- Assist communities with providing increased opportunities to live, work, and play.

# Program Priorities & Focus

## Program Provides

Short-term technical assistance for regional land-use/transportation priorities at the community level.

## Priority Activities & Areas of Focus

- Multimodal Transportation Options
- Transit Oriented Development\*
- Land Use Enhancements in Activity Centers
- Access to Transit
- Regional Trail Connections
- Climate Change Adaptation
- Equitable Access for Vulnerable Populations\*

*\*Applications that address Transit Oriented Development and/or equitable access for vulnerable populations are eligible for additional points in the proposal evaluation (per TC survey).*

# Eligibility & Support

## Eligibility

- Local jurisdictions that are voting members of the BRTB
- Inter-agency and inter-jurisdictional partnerships encouraged

## Support

- Successful proposals will demonstrate strong local support.
- Applications for planning or preliminary design must implement features of a locally approved plan or project, support the funding priorities outlined above and fall into one of the two types of projects described below.

## Project types

- Technical assistance for planning or preliminary design (up to 30%) that support local plans and help implement changes to the built environment that reduce traffic on roads and address one or more regional funding priorities.

# Type of Assistance

- Short-term consultant services for eligible planning and preliminary design projects, generally up to 1 year in duration
  - Maximum of \$100,000 towards
- Recipients will not receive direct financial assistance.
- A pre-qualified pool of consultants has been selected to perform the work via a Request for Qualifications

# Selection Criteria and Scoring

<b>Improve access to opportunities for people of all ages and abilities.</b>	0-5 pts
<b>Increase travel options to optimize mobility.</b>	0-5 pts
<b>Assist communities with providing increased opportunities to live, work, and play.</b>	0-5 pts
<b>Alignment with Funding Priorities / Program Focal Areas</b>	
<b>Multimodal Transportation Options</b>	0-10 pts
<b>Transit Oriented Development</b>	0-15 pts
<b>Land Use Enhancements in Activity Centers</b>	0-10 pts
<b>Access to Transit</b>	0-10 pts
<b>Regional Trail Connections</b>	0-10 pts
<b>Climate Change Adaptation</b>	0-10 pts
<b>Additional Points: Equitable Access for Vulnerable Populations</b>	Up to 5 additional pts

Public involvement	0-10 pts
Collaboration	0-5 pts
Community Commitment	
Additional Staff Roles	0-5 pts
Funding Plan	0-10 pts
Maximum Score	140 pts
