



Freight Plan Overview



















Purpose

To examine existing and projected conditions, and identify policy positions, strategies, and freight projects to improve freight movement efficiency and safety.

A safe and reliable freight system leads to lower costs of goods that consumers and companies need for good quality of life and successful enterprise. Ensuring that the network of highways, railways, waterways, and airports are ready to handle the current level and anticipated growth of goods movement is a priority of the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT).



Overview

The State Freight Plan update will focus on:

- Comprehensive overview of freight movement in Maryland
- Freight supply chain or technology influences
- Identifying policy needs and strategies




