2,000 Customers per Month use Transit Link Card (TLC) for travel on MTA & WMATA Systems



SmarTrip® & CharmCard®


can be used on MTA Local Services and D.C. Area Transit Services

- Very little crossover between DC Area Transit and MTA Local Services (Less than 100 each day)
- MTA Passes (1-Day, 7-Day, & 31-Day) are not accepted by D.C. Area Transit Services. Only stored value can be used across all systems.
- MTA does not accept D.C. Area Transit passes



Regional Daily Ridership


- D.C. Area Daily Ridership (73.959%)
