

## 2020-2023 TIP Amendment: SHA Bridge Replacements on MD 151 and MD 151B

#### **AMENDMENT PURPOSE**


 Increase construction funding from \$20 million to \$30 million







#### **LOCATION**









# REASON FOR INCREASED CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

- To accommodate increased truck weight loads at the request of the Port
- Additional fill needed to avoid significant settlement
- Treatment and disposal of hazardous soils at site
- Ramp bridge on MD 151B transitioned from deck replacement to full replacement







#### **BRIDGE ELEMENTS**

- Bridge no. 0309900 (MD 151 over MD 151 B)
  - Poor rated bridge built in 1954
  - 4 lanes to 4 lanes
  - Profile raised for increased rail clearance
- Bridge no. 0335100 (MD 151 B)
  - Poor rated bridge built in 1957
  - 2 lanes to 2 lanes
  - Profile raised for increased rail clearance
  - Sidewalk added at request of Tradepoint Atlantic







## **BRIDGE ELEMENTS (continued)**

- Bridge no. 0335000 (ramp bridge)
  - Fair rated bridge built in 1957
  - 1 lane to 1 lane
  - Full replacement needed to raise profile for increased vehicle clearance and truck volume







#### **SCHEDULE**

- Advertisement: upon BRTB and federal approval of TIP amendment
- Construction notice to proceed: Spring 2020
- Project completion: 2023
