




4. TIM Self-Assessment Follow-Up

- Q 35: Do TIM responders routinely utilize traffic control procedures to provide back of queue warning?
 - No policies in place for back of queue notification. For very long events, SHA may stage a truck at the end of the queue but that resource is not always available. Nearby dynamic message signs are often used to alert drivers about incidents and queues ahead.


