The purpose of this memo is to request your approval of the attached Mater Agreement 4206. This award is the result of competitive bidding through Purchasing's solicitation process.

### Recommended Awardee(s):

Public Works – Traffic and Transportation is requesting approval of a Master Agreement with Ennis Flint, Inc. This MA is for a five year term contract for Glass Beads. These Glass Beads are used in traffic road paint to increase the reflective capabilities of road paint in road markings. A competitive solicitation was posted and Ennis Flint was the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

Baltimore County was the lead agency for this solicitation. Three other jurisdictions will piggyback this contract as part of the Baltimore Regional Cooperative Purchasing Committee. Harford, Howard and Carroll Counties all submitted usage estimates and the solicitation reflected the combined usage to potentially obtain lower pricing based on this combined usage.
