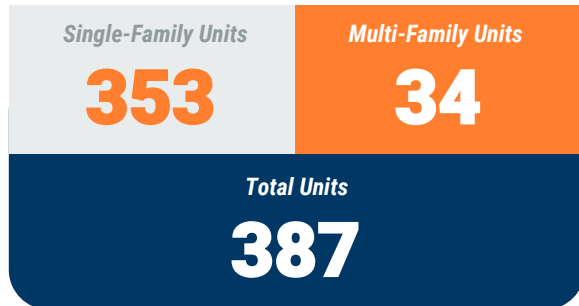

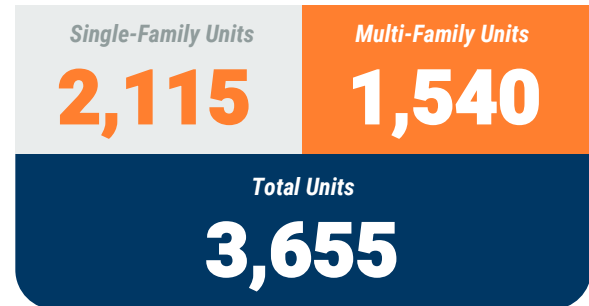
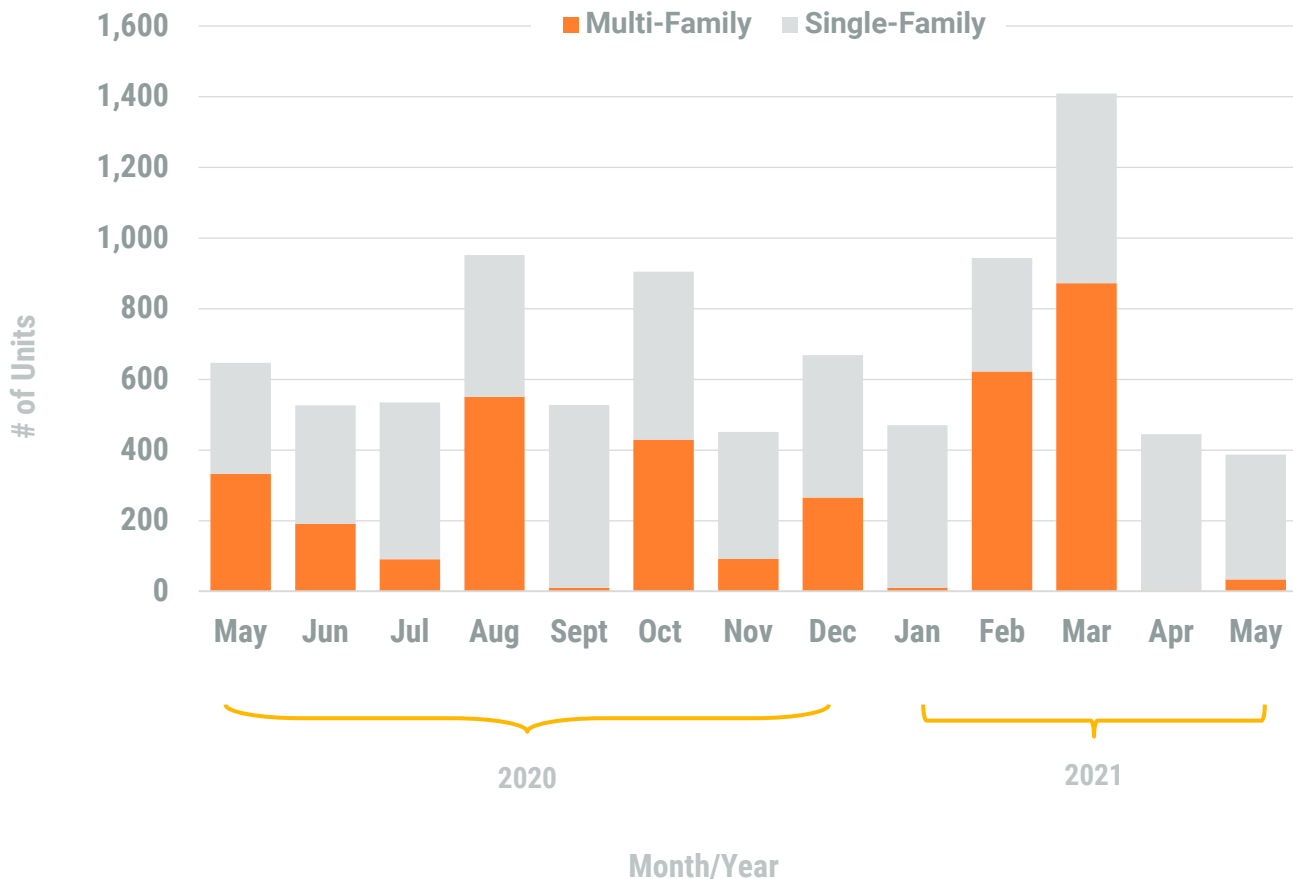


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

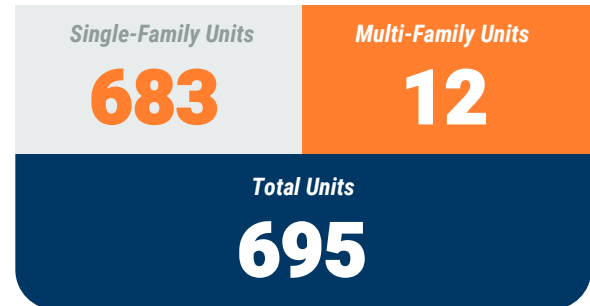
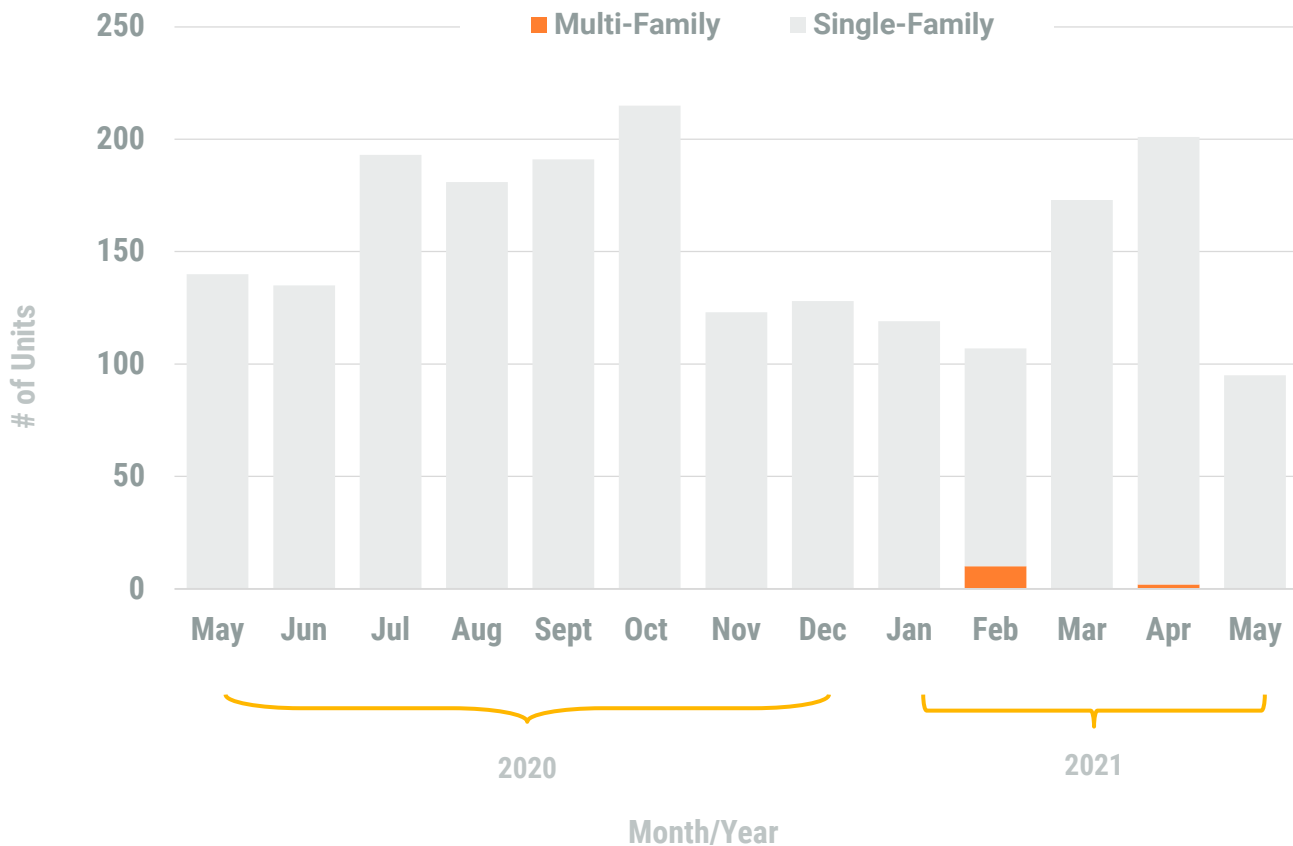


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

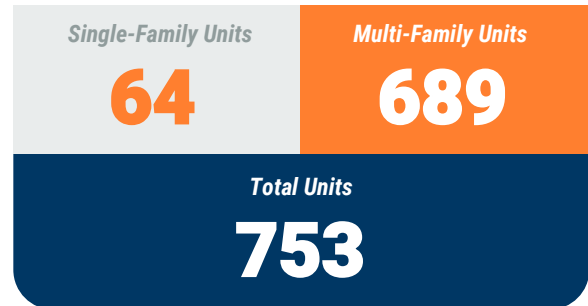
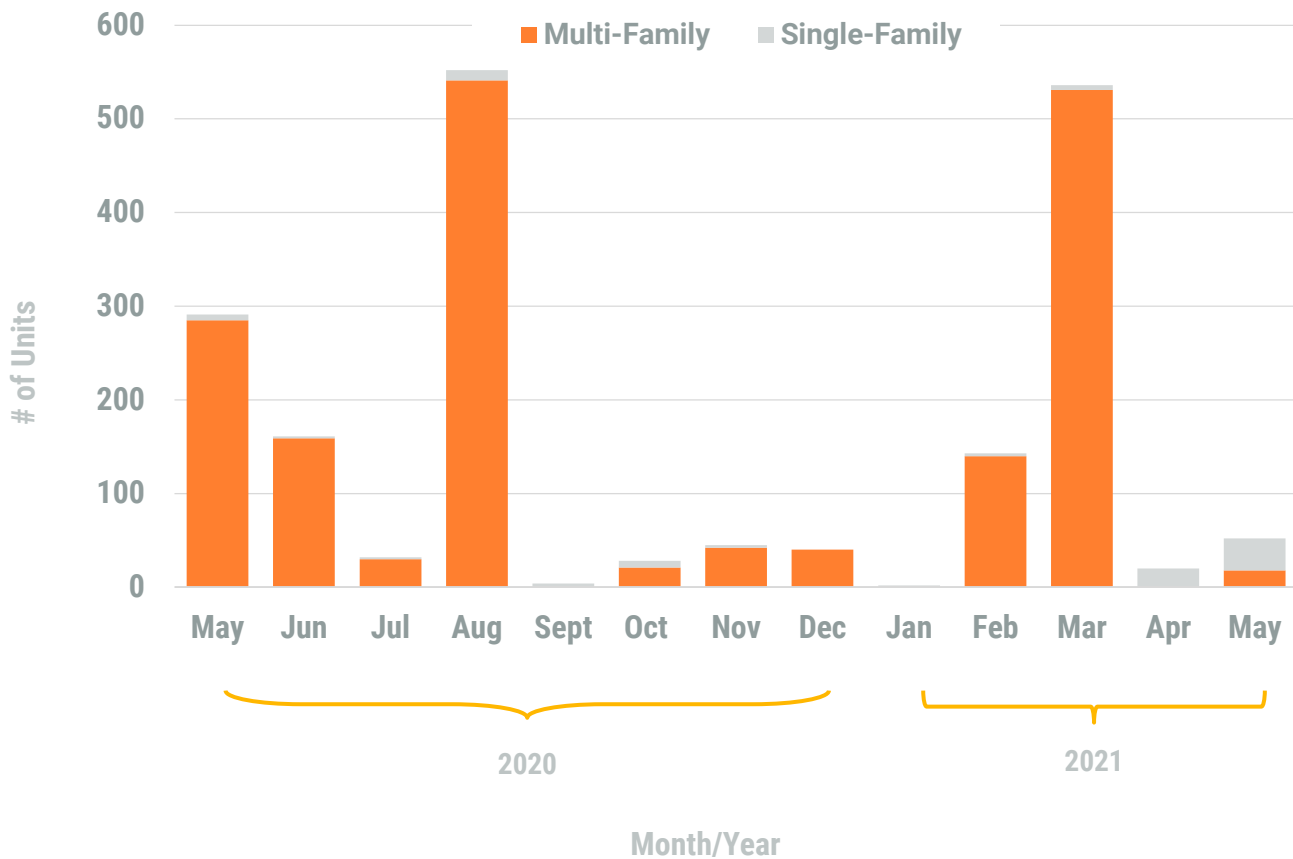


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

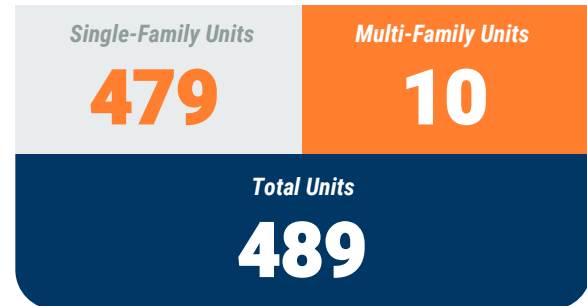
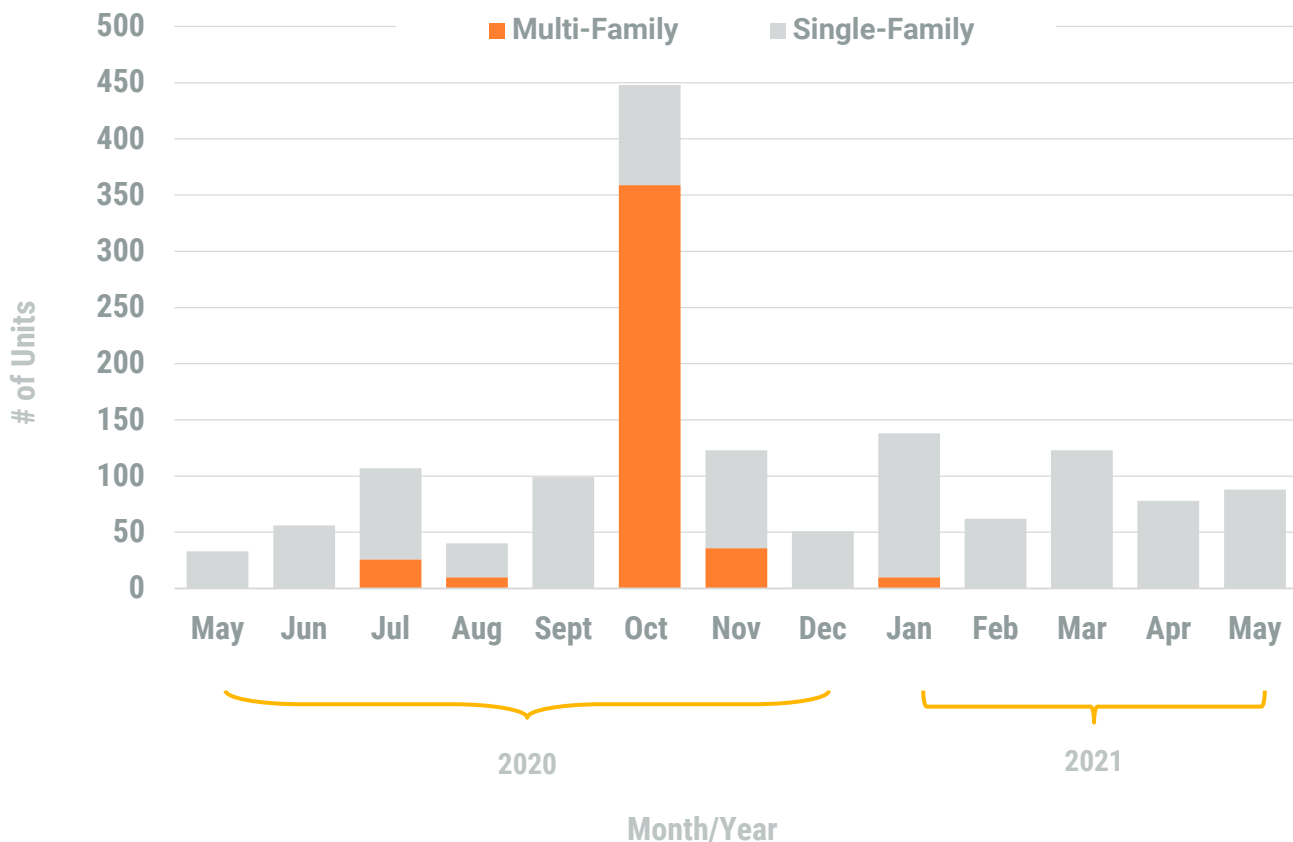


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

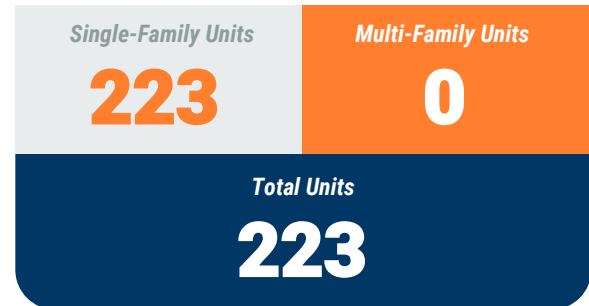
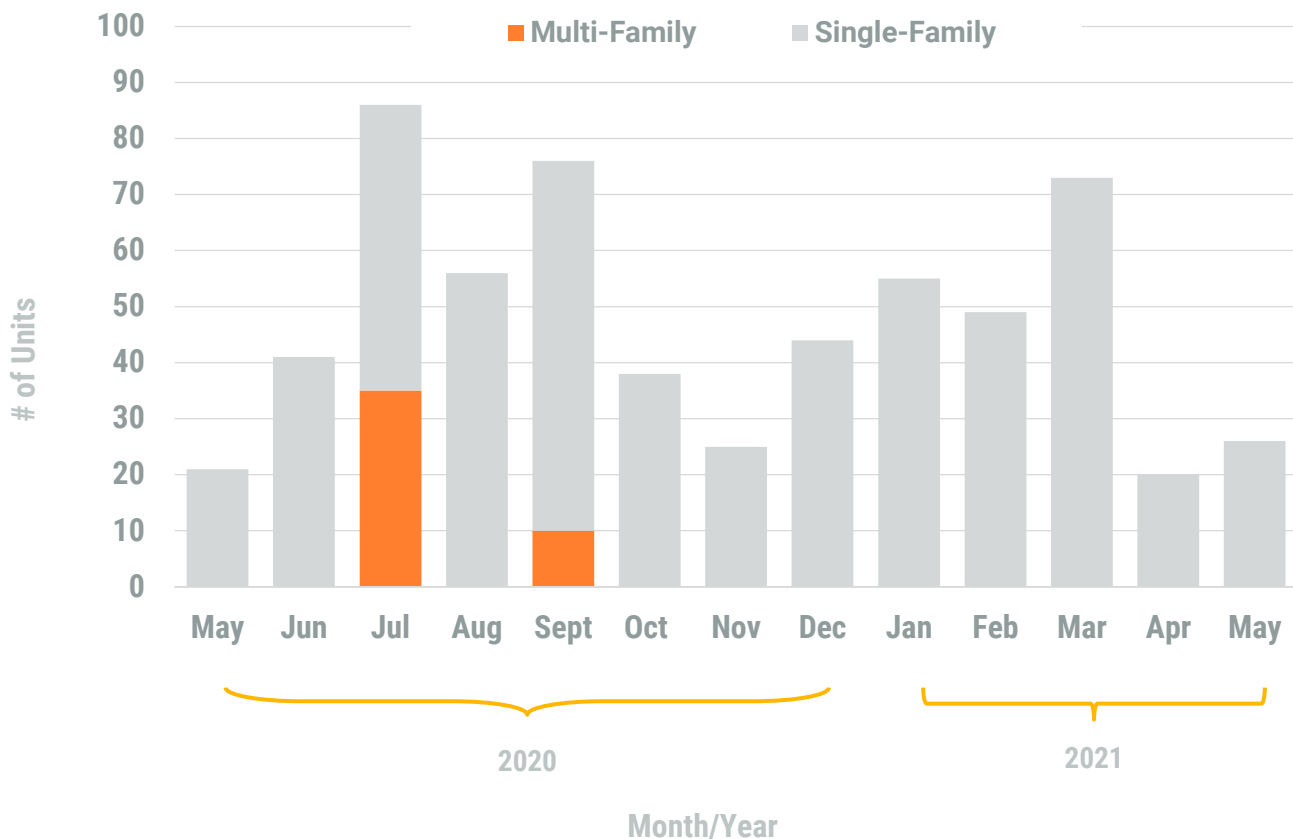


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

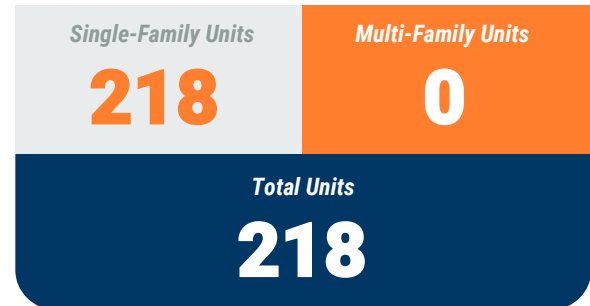
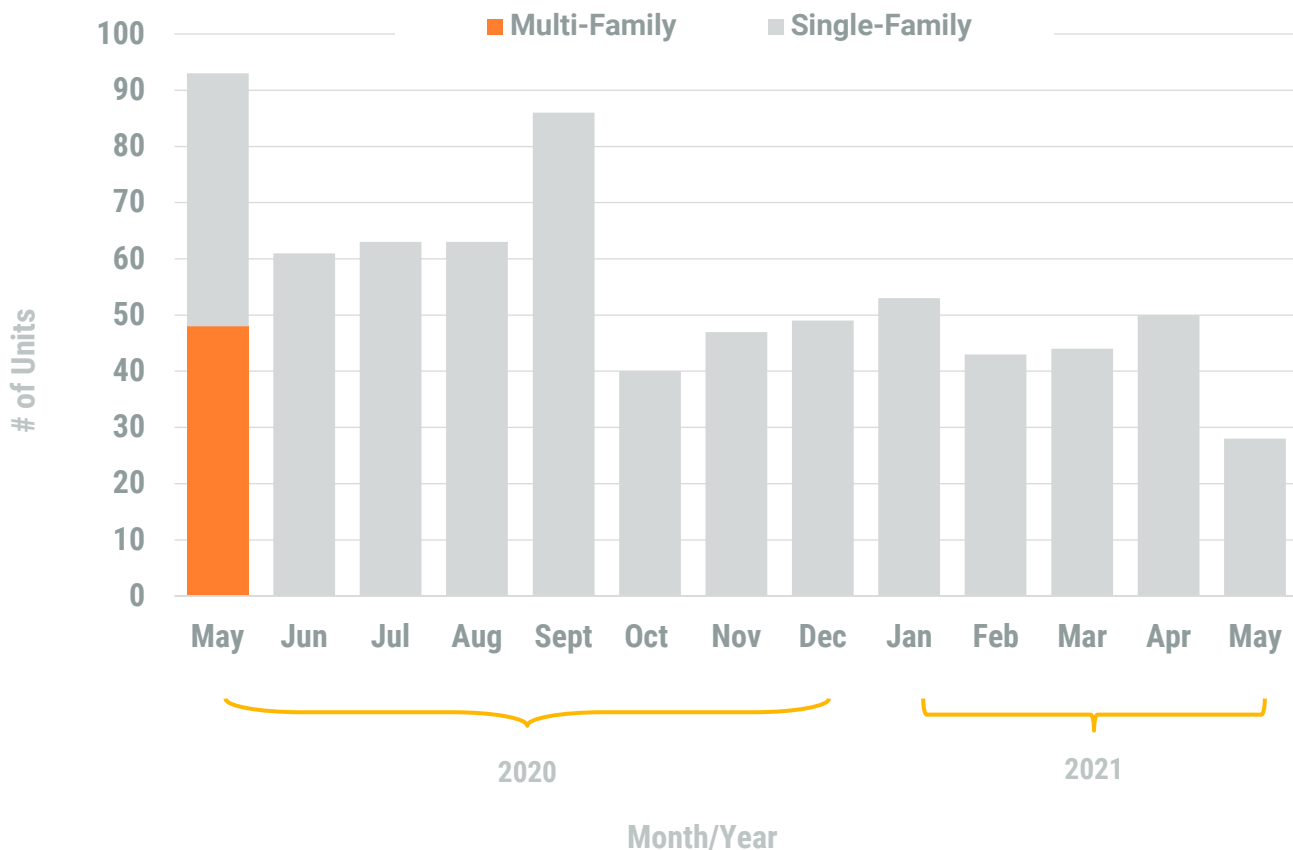


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

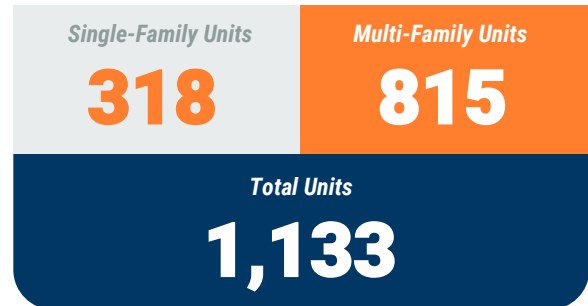
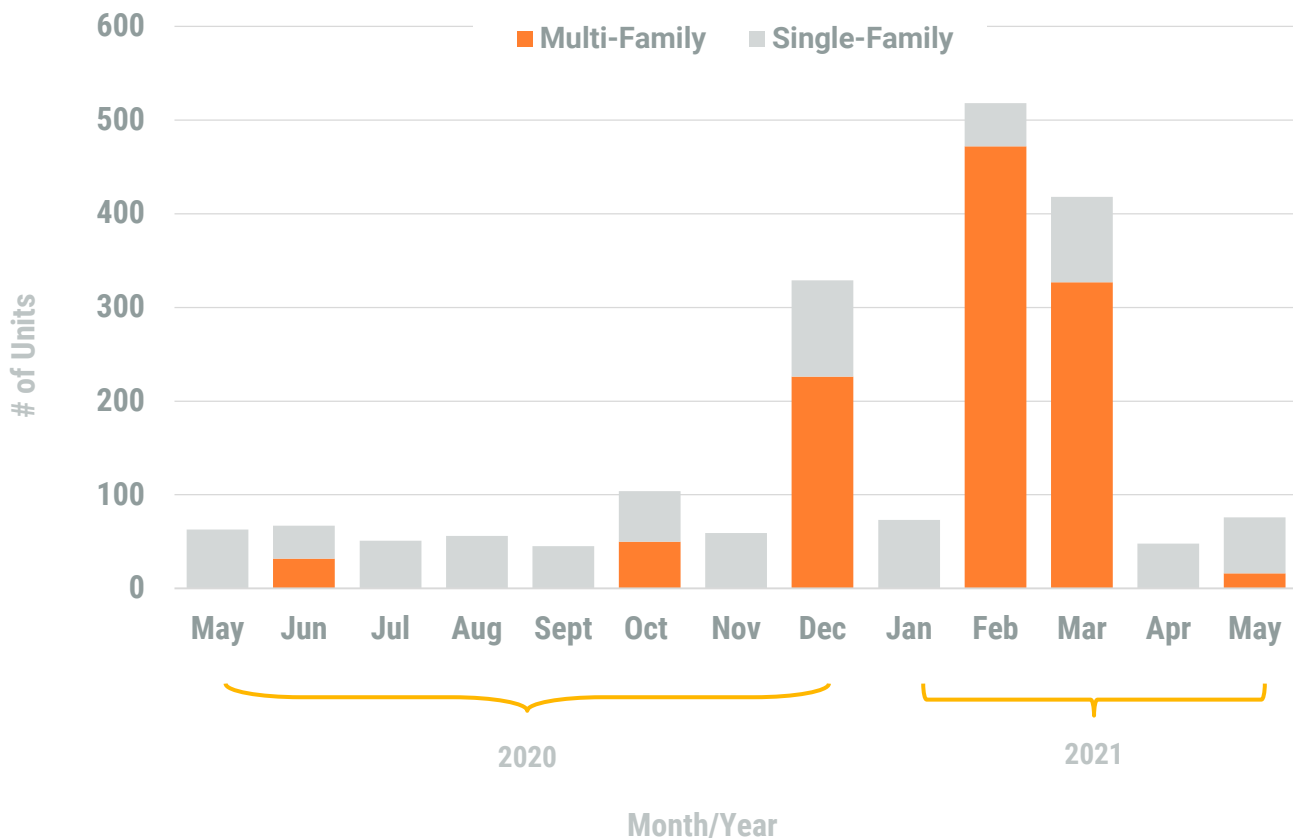


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

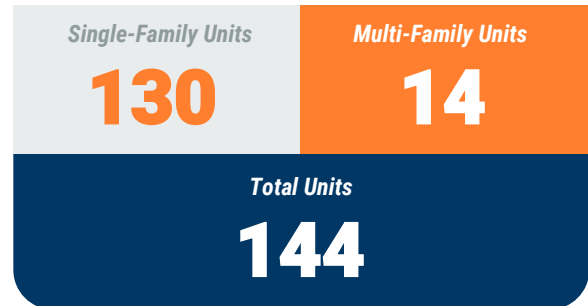
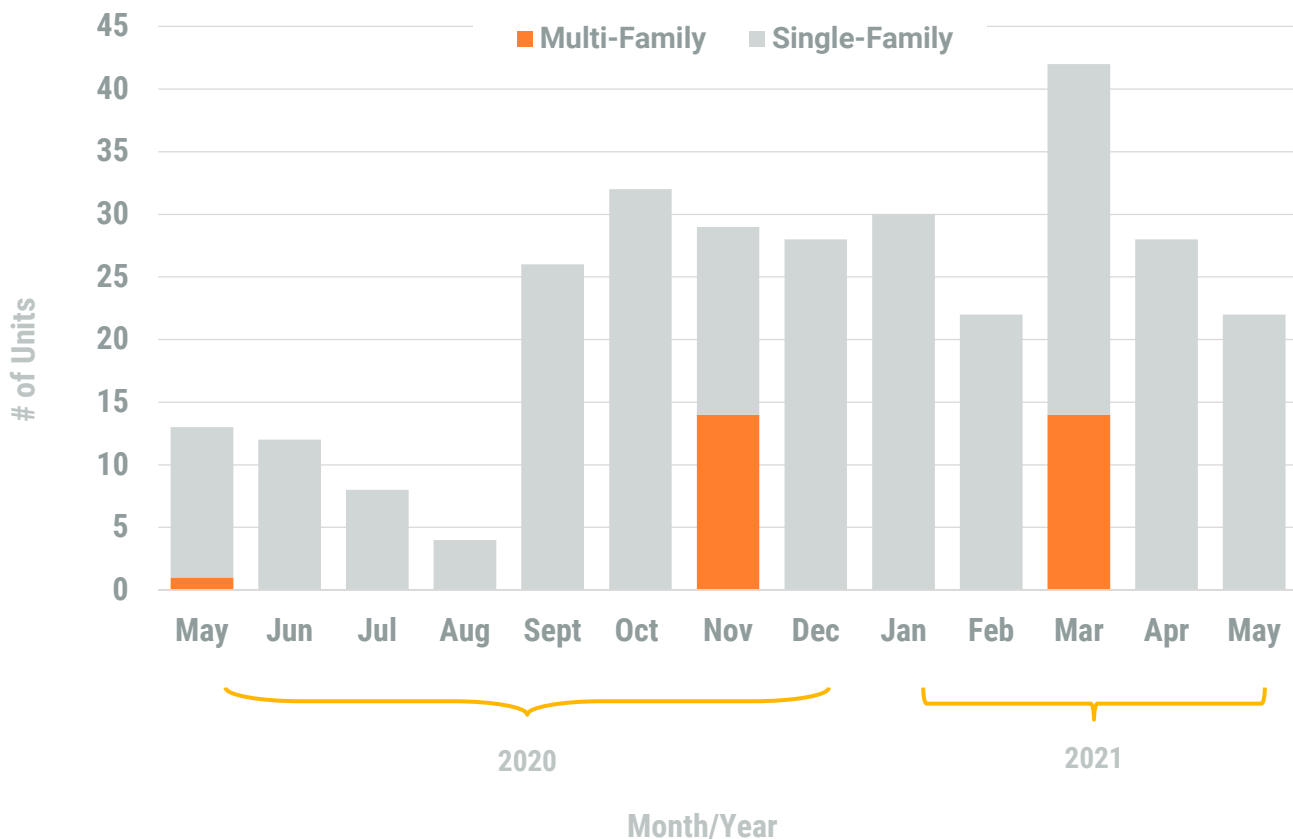


Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)

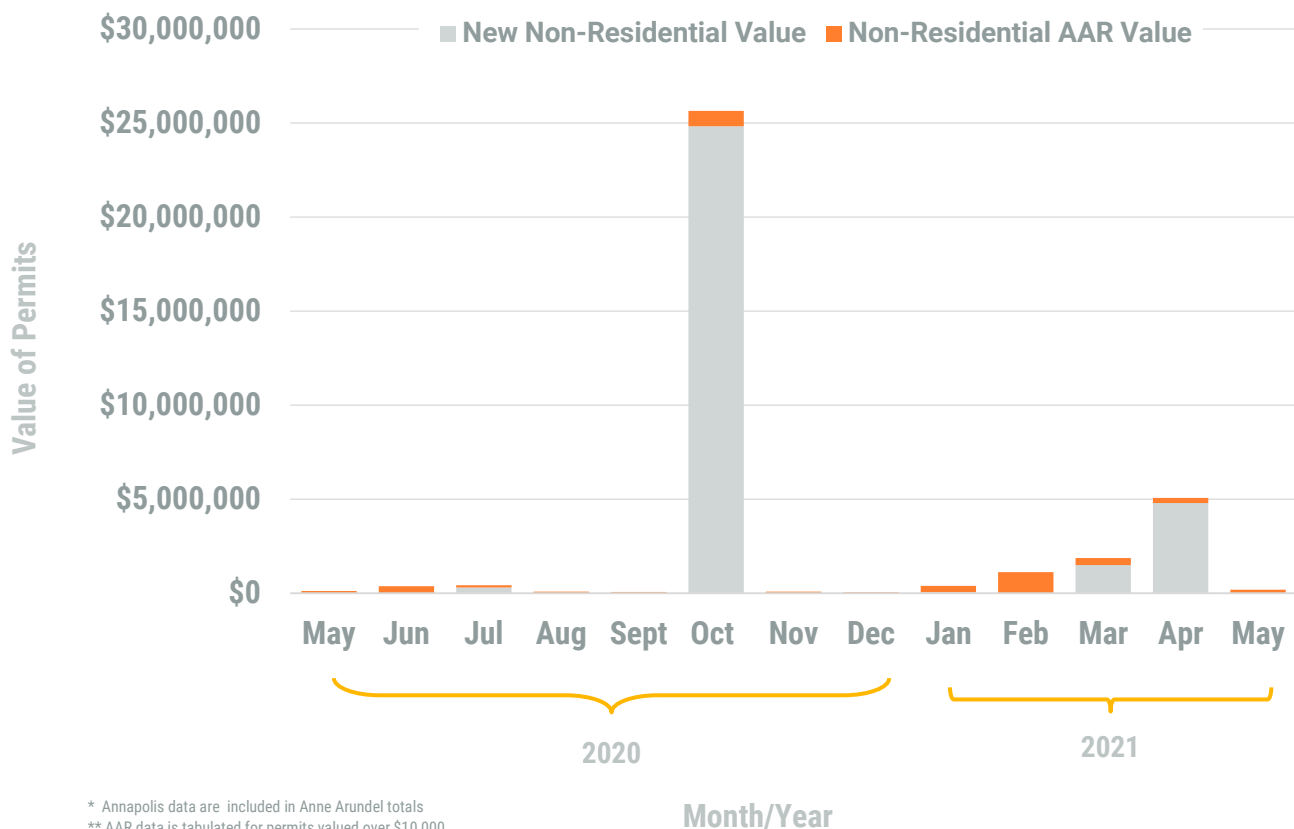
