












Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)




Exhibit 2: Non-Residential Construction Permit Activity (13-Month)





Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)













Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)










